ROOM IN THE INN

St. Clare is again serving as an inn through Room in the Inn-Berea, for people experiencing homelessness through the cold months. We are hosting guests each Friday evening through Mar. 20, 2020. There is a sign-up sheet in the narthex for all who wish to assist. Please complete the form again even if you helped last year.

Members of the parish who want to interact with guests will need to complete diocesan training for interaction with vulnerable populations. Please contact the parish office for more information about the diocesan training. RITI training is also required—please contact Mary Calie for assistance in setting up a RITI training session.

There are many ways to help: as an innkeeper (at least two trained volunteer innkeepers are needed to stay overnight at the church each Friday); to transport guests from the registration site to the church; to set up for and clean up after dinner; to provide the evening meal and serve it to guests; to set up for and clean up after breakfast; to provide breakfast and serve it to guests; to provide sack lunches for guests to take with them when they leave; to deflate mattresses and clean up after guests depart; to launder bedding; etc.
