Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is Feb. 26. It is a day of fasting and abstinence. All those between 18 and 60 who are healthy are required to fast—they are only allowed one meal that day and two smaller meals that together do not exceed one regular meal (no snacks). All Catholics age 14 through death must abstain from meat. The Ash Wednesday schedule is:

- 8:00 a.m.: Mass and imposition of ashes, St. Clare
- 12:00 p.m.: Liturgy of the word and imposition of ashes, Danforth Chapel, Berea College
- 5:00 p.m.: Liturgy of the word and imposition of ashes, Our Lady of Mt. Vernon
- 7:00 p.m.: Mass and imposition of ashes, St. Paul
- 7:00 p.m.: Proper liturgy with imposition of ashes, St. Clare—**Bilingual**

Opportunity for Reconciliation

Go ahead and mark your calendars now for the Bilingual Penance Service on March 5 at 7:00 p.m. at St. Clare.
