Please don't forget second collections! **The second collection this weekend (September 13) is for the Holy Land.** The 2020 Pontifical Good Friday Collection for the Holy Land was postponed this year due to the pandemic, and is being taken up this weekend instead. The Christian communities in the Holy Land, now exposed to the risk of Covid-19 and living in contexts already full of serious suffering, benefit every year from the generosity of the faithful from all over the world. This solidarity enables them to continue their evangelical presence, in addition to maintaining schools and social structures that assist all citizens with healthcare, education and peaceful coexistence, attending above all to the weakest and poorest. Please be as generous as you can. If you are unable to attend Mass in person, you may mail your offering to the Church.

Special Need: Due to an outside water leak, there is currently no water in the Church (thus, the bathrooms are out of order). The two main alternatives for fixing the problem are: (a) to run a new line from the meter to the Church main, or (b) to close the meter and connect the Church to the water meter in Friendship Hall. We are still exploring options, but whatever solution is decided upon, the cost will be in the \$9,000-\$10,000 range.
